TUITION / FEES INFORMATION † Registration will close on September 15 – NO REGISTRATIONS OF THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS

Payment must accompany registration; registrations without payment will be put on a waiting list. No family however is denied religious education because of an inability to pay - please speak with Sarah Hogan to arrange a payment plan or other considerations.

\$120 tuition and materials fee per student 1st through 8th grade (\$20 materials fee included)

OR *\$80 tuition and materials fee per student in a pre-K - 3, 4, or 5 year old class (\$20 materials fee included)*

plus \$25 additional fee charged for Family Program Families

† Total amount due is capped at \$350 per family

† **MINIMUM STUDENTS / CATECHIST PER CLASS** Monday classes must have a minimum of 8 students and a volunteer Catechist to be offered. Parents will be notified on about September 1 if their child's class has not met this requirement. Classes are capped at 12 - 15 students.

† **Volunteer Tuition DISCOUNTS** All families are encouraged to take on a volunteer commitment! Parents of students who take on a year-long commitment pay no tuition for any of their students (*all families must still pay the \$20 materials fee for each student*).

Full year volunteer opportunities: *Catechists and Adult Classroom aides (we're especially looking for middle-school catechists)*

Smaller volunteer commitments: *help with Advent treats, end of the year party / treats, Catechist dinner, sacrament meetings and more*
